

Covid Safe Plan for the Brindabella Bushwalking Club

BBC is required to have a plan for the resumption of Club activities. This will need to vary as ACT Government recommendations change however the principles will stay much the same.

- No person is to attend Club activities if they are feeling unwell.
- It is expected that persons attending Club activities will be fully vaccinated against the Covid virus. For those unvaccinated, for your own protection, we recommend you refrain from participating in Club activities at this time.
- Participants must comply with the restrictions applicable to the wearing of face coverings that are set out in the Health Directive at [Covid19.act.gov.au](https://www.covid19.act.gov.au) and discuss any concerns with the leader prior to the walk.
- Distancing of 1.5 metres is required while walking and this should be extended to two metres if face masks are removed during vigorous exercise.
- To facilitate contact tracing you will be required to provide your current contact details as well as your usual emergency contacts.
- Each participant must monitor the ACT Government's Exposure Location Website prior to the commencement of a walk to ensure that you have not been to any affected sites. <https://www.covid19.act.gov.au/act-status-and-response/act-covid-19-exposure-locations#ACT-exposure-locations>
- While car sharing is permitted and will be organised in the usual manner by the leader, you are quite welcome to use your own car.

This Plan will apply to all BBC activities for the November and December 2021 Walks Program.
